TODA Obtains Certification as a “DX-Certified Operator” under the METI DX Certification Program

TODA KOGYO CORP. (hereafter, “TODA”) is pleased to announce that it has obtained certification as a “DX-Certified Operator” under the Digital Transformation (DX) Certification Program established by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (hereafter, “METI”).



Digital Transformation Certification

1. About the Certification Obtained

This certification is a national program granted by the Government of Japan to companies that have established an organizational framework for driving business transformation with digital technologies, in accordance with the *Digital Governance Code*, a set of guidelines formulated by METI to promote DX.

TODA earned this certification in recognition of its strong efforts to strengthen its management foundation through digital technologies and to advance the reform of its business processes.

2. DX Initiatives

Since its founding in 1823, TODA has advanced the development of materials centered on fine particle synthesis technologies and has supplied a wide range of inorganic materials, including magnet materials, dielectric materials, and soft magnetic materials.

Recognizing the rapid changes taking place in society, TODA positions DX as operational efficiency, productivity enhancement, advanced quality management, and a foundation for value creation, and promotes DX as a key initiative within its management strategy.

3. Major DX Initiatives

- **Establishment of the Digital Innovation Department**

As an organization reporting directly to the President and CEO, the department drives company-wide initiatives including factory IoT, IT infrastructure enhancement, cybersecurity reinforcement, and data analytics.

- **Business Process Innovation through Digital Application**

By utilizing generative AI and data-analytics tools, TODA promotes improvements in yield rates and centralized management of test items and priority themes for business expansion.

- **Strengthening the Digital Foundation through the Introduction of a Next-Generation Core System**

TODA is implementing a next-generation system that integrates production, sales, and cost information. This initiative promotes the development of a digital foundation that enables reduced paper resources, the digitization of production daily reports, and faster information sharing. (Full-scale operation is scheduled to begin in May 2026)

- **Enhancement of DX Talent Development Programs**

Through distance-learning programs on AI and IoT, as well as fundamental data-analytics training, TODA works to improve the digital skills of all employees and develop key users across the organization.

4. Outlook

TODA will continue to deepen and expand its company-wide DX initiatives, aiming to further strengthen its business foundation and create next-generation businesses, while contributing to the realization of a sustainable society.
